

FACTS**WHAT DOES PATHWARD®, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

The terms of this Privacy Policy only apply to you if you open an account or use our prepaid card, debit card, secured charge card, or related products or services.

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and account balances
- Payment history and account transactions
- Transaction history and purchase history

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Pathward, N.A., chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Pathward, N.A., protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information, and we also limit access to information to those employees for whom access is necessary.
How does Pathward, N.A., collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an account or register your card ▪ Make a purchase or other transaction ▪ Provide us card or account information or give us your income information We also collect your personal information from other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Pathward, N.A., has no affiliates with which it shares your personal information.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include direct marketing companies.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>We may partner with nonaffiliated financial companies to jointly market financial products or services to you.</i>

Other important information

California or Vermont residents: We will not share your personal information with nonaffiliates, except for our own marketing purposes, our everyday business purposes, or with your consent.

For Vermont residents: We will not share your credit information or information about your creditworthiness, transaction, or experience, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
